

## Where We Row

Lake Lemon was built in 1952 as part of a water supply program for the City of Bloomington. The City has never tapped into these waters located 10 miles east of the city and it has become a haven for outdoor enthusiasts. The lake is the 11th largest lake in the state of Indiana and the 7th largest public reservoir, with 1,650 acres, 24 miles of shoreline, and an average depth of 9.7 feet.

Rowers share the lake with all types of habitat including eagles, osprey, geese, ducks, swans, and countless other water birds and mammals who call Lake Lemon home.

Lake Lemon is also home to the IU Rowing Hoosiers, the Bloomington Yacht Club, the Boys and Girls Club, and Riddle Point Park.

For those that are new to the sport of rowing, we offer Discover Rowing and Learn to Row classes. Please check our website for more information on upcoming classes.

### **Discover Rowing**

Discover Rowing is a FREE 90 minute session at Lake Lemon to learn about the sport, equipment, terminology, and even a chance to get in a racing shell for the first time. ### **Learn to Row**

Learn to Row is designed to be a short and fun introductory course in the sport of rowing. LTR usually consists of four 90-minute classes held over two weeks (either MON/WED or TUES/THURS evenings). You will be in a quad with three other rowers learning how to handle a boat both on and off the water. Completion of this class will allow you to join RPRA and continue to row with RPRA for the season. Cost is \$75.00.
